## Lee's News



Welcome back to term 4. As usual our eager learners have returned with gusto and have returned to kindy like ducks to water. It's scary to think that this is our last term together, especially when I think back to our first days and reflect on how far each and every child has travelled in just 3 terms.

When I think about our Early Years Learning Framework (EYLF), Belonging, Being and Becoming, I think that term 4 is very much about children *becoming* powerful, brave and competent learners about to embark on what will be one of the biggest transitions in their lives, starting school. As parents and families, we have a massive role to play in supporting our children and ourselves through this change. To help support you through this process, on the 8<sup>th</sup> of November, we are holding a Parent workshop, called 'Leaving the Nest- talking effective strategies to support children as they transition to school'. Included in this, we will share some of the key messages from our attendance at the Early Childhood Conference, where we were lucky enough to attend a key note from Dr Stuart Shanker- World Leading Neuroscientist, specialising in child development and Self-Regulation. We will share current research on brain development, effective strategies, handy hints and facilitate discussion around how we can work together to support your child to transition to school. Remember, when we talk about transition, we aren't talking about transition visits or orientation visits, we are talking about how we can support a child to emotionally, intellectually and physically flourish as they move from one educational setting to another.



After many, many months of hard work from many people, we have finally submitted our application for the excellent rating with ACECQA (Australian Children's Education & Care Quality Authority).

This process has allowed us to track, document and deliver a concise yet detailed account of our journey of where we are today, addressing specific criteria in relation to how we provide and operate an excellent service. The excellent rating process is rigorous and requires in depth analysis and proof of how we operate at a level that far exceeds the assessment and rating process. Our application's theme was titled



-Lobethal Community Kindergarten- Agents for Growth and Change-. Through our application we shared our story around the changes we have made across our community and system through our children being advocates for nature education and preservation. The process should take approximately 2 months, so we are hopeful of a result in the days before Christmas. We will keep you posted with information as we receive it.



Thank you to everyone for all of the lovely messages of support for me as a finalist in the Leadership category in the South Australian Public Education Awards.

Although I didn't take out the award, it was lovely to be nominated and to make it as a top 3 finalist was truly special. The incredible support and kindness I have received has been overwhelming and I wanted to express my heartfelt thanks to our community for all of the love. You are all so kind!

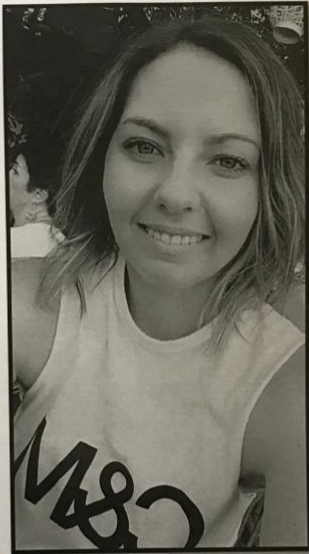
